2) School Achievements

We are pleased to share with you the following achievements of our pupils in the past month.

3) Global Awareness Programme to Suzhou and Shanghai

32 of our Primary 5 pupils and 5 staff have travelled to Suzhou and Shanghai in China as part of our 6 Days 5 Nights Global Awareness Programme from Friday to Wednesday, 11 to 16 November 2016. The group will be visiting 2 schools in Changshu, Suzhou, as well as cultural and educational sights in Suzhou and Shanghai.

4) <u>Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) Fair</u>

CCA is an integral part of our pupils' holistic education. Through CCA, pupils discover their interests and talents while developing values and competencies that will prepare them for a rapidly changing world.

CCA also promotes friendships among pupils from diverse backgrounds as they learn, play and grow together. Participation in CCA fosters social integration and deepens pupils' sense of belonging, commitment and sense of responsibility to school, community and nation. CCA in Jing Shan Primary School is open to all P2 to P6 pupils. The school strongly encourages every pupil to participate in at least one CCA.

As part of the review of the spread of CCA offered in Jing Shan, the Drama Club and Red Cross will not be offered next year. In addition, Robotics Club will only be available to P4 to P6 pupils next year. As such, pupils in these CCA groups are to register for another CCA.

CCA Fair for P1 – P3 Pupils

The annual Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) Fair took place on Thursday, 10 November 2016 for the P1 – P3 pupils. The CCA Fair was a platform to showcase the various CCA in the school. Pupils were exposed to all the CCA available in the school and learnt about the new skills they could pick up from each CCA.

P4 and P5 Pupils

P4 pupils who wish to remain in the same CCA <u>do not</u> have to take part in this registration exercise. Those who wish to switch CCA can register through AsknLearn. P5 pupils should not change their CCA.

Online Registration

All P1-P5 pupils are to exercise their CCA option by Thursday, 17 November 2016. Registration will be open on AsknLearn from **Saturday**, **12 November 2016 to Thursday**, **17 November 2016.** The detailed instructions for registration are attached with this letter. Pupils who are unable to do the registration at home will be able to do so during **their recess on Tuesday 15 November to Thursday 17 November 2016**. Laptops will be available in the canteen for pupils to do their registration.

5) Career Fair

On Tuesday, 15 November 2016, the school organized a Career Fair for P5 and P6 pupils. The fair aims to create an awareness of the careers in the various industries, as part of the school's efforts in education and career guidance. As part of the Fair, the school invited guest speakers from various industries to speak and to share their work experiences with pupils.

Our graduating cohort were also involved in preparing a static exhibition of the various industries such as the Arts, Health and Aviation industries for our P3 to P4 pupils. Through the process of setting up an exhibition for their juniors, the P6 pupils had the opportunity to hone their 21st century competencies like communication and collaboration.

6) Report Books and Booklists

The school will be issuing report books, portfolios and booklists to our pupils on Thursday, 17 November 2016. Please sign and return the report book on the first day of school next year on Tuesday, 3 January 2017.

7) **P6 Graduation Ceremony**

All P5 and P6 pupils are invited to attend the Graduation Ceremony on Friday, 18 November 2016, from 8 am to 10.00am. Guests and parents of Primary 6 pupils are to be seated by 7.45 am. P5 and P6 pupils are to report to school in full school uniform by 7.15am. P5 prize recipients are required to stay on for the Prize-Giving Day Ceremony and report to the registration counter in the hall at 10.15am. All other pupils from Primary 1 to 4 are not required to report to school. Alphajoy Student Care Centre will operate as usual.

8) Prize-Giving Ceremony

All P1 to P5 prize winners and their family members are invited to attend the Prize-Giving Ceremony on Friday, 18 November 2016, from 11am to 1.00pm. All guests are to be seated by 10.45 am. Prize-winners are to report to school in full school uniform by 10.00 am. All other pupils are not required to report to school. Alphajoy Student Care Centre will operate as usual.

9) Release of PSLE results, Secondary 1 Posting Exercise and Collection of PSLE Certificates

PSLE results is tentatively scheduled to be released between 24 and 28 November 2016. The date of the PSLE results release would be informed via a press release a few days before the actual date. All pupils are to report to school by 11.00 am in the school hall, in their full school uniform to collect their results. For Pupil/parent/guardian who is unable to collect the PSLE result slip, the pupil's parent/guardian may nominate another adult to collect the PSLE results slip, using the Proxy Form in "Choosing your Secondary Schools for admission to Secondary One in 2017" booklet issued by Pupil Placement Section or download the form from http://moe.gov.sg/education/admissions/secondary-one-posting/.

Secondary 1 Posting Exercise will be conducted via Secondary 1 - Internet System (S1-IS). The system will be accessible for 7 calendar days starting from the release of PSLE results. S1-IS is accessible 24 hours starting from 11.00 am on the first day until 3 pm on the last day of the S1 Option Phase.

Pupils can also exercise the posting options through the school for 5 working days starting from the release of PSLE results. You may choose to submit your options through the school which starts from 11 am to 3 pm on the first day; and 9 am to 3 pm on the last day of S1 Option Phase. All primary schools will not be open on weekends. For pupils who miss the one week period for submission of options, they can approach the school for assistance the day after the submission closes, from 9 am to 12 pm. This half day submission is only for new submission of S1 school choices and not for amendments to submitted options.

The release of Secondary 1 Posting Results is expected to be on Wednesday, 21 December 2016 (tentative) and the registration at posted Secondary Schools on Thursday, 22 December 2016 at 8.30am (tentative).

All P6 pupils may collect their PSLE Certificates from the General Office from Friday, 9 December 2016. Your child/ward has to bring his/her EZ-Link card for verification.

10) FairPrice Share-A-Textbook 2016

The school will be supporting FairPrice's annual Share-A-Textbook Project. This meaningful activity ties in with our school value of Generosity, and encourages our pupils to show care and empathy to the needy through the donation of their used textbooks. 14) Travel Declaration via ASKnLearn™ Learning Management System

As required by the Ministry of Education, <u>all Primary 1 pupils</u> are required to submit a travel declaration or a NIL return if you are not travelling. For <u>Primary 2 to 6 pupils</u>, a submission is only required if pupils are travelling overseas during the November/December holidays.

Your child/ward can complete the online submission via the ASKnLearn[™] Learning Management System. Alternatively, you may submit the Online Travel Declaration on behalf of your child/ward via the ASKnLearn[™] Parents' Portal. Online travel declaration is available from Tuesday, 1 November 2016 to Saturday, 31 December 2016.

15) **PERI Upgrading**

The date for the construction works to begin for the new school buildings is tentatively scheduled in the second half of 2017. The school will provide more details of the upgrading plans and timeline next year. We seek your continued understanding, support and partnership, as we work with you to ensure a conducive environment for the quality education of our pupils.

16) School Curriculum Hours in 2016

From next year, the school will include a second snack break for our children. Studies have shown that students, particularly younger students, have smaller stomachs that are unable to retain sufficient energy to meet their high energy expenditure. Moreover, pupils who take the school bus may take as long as 1 hour to reach home after school dismissal and this would delay their lunch. Hence, having a snack break before they go home can help to ensure that students do not go hungry for an extended period of time.

A designated 10-minute break would be set aside for our pupils to eat dry finger food in class. Consequently, the school day will end at 1.40pm and supplementary/remedial lessons in the afternoon will be shortened from 45 min to 40 min each. 17) First day of school, 3 January 2017, Tuesday
