#### 2) School Achievements

#### Environment

Jing Shan has achieved the Lotus Sustained Achievement Award in the SEC-StarHub School Green Awards (SGA) this year. The SEC-StarHub School Green Awards is a simple environmental programme for all schools in Singapore. Students work together in teams to review their school's environmental efforts and submit a report. Through this, students gain a better understanding of the environmental impact of their actions and benefit from the opportunity to participate in programmes to raise awareness about the environment. Based on the results, schools qualify for one of four awards – the Palm, Hibiscus, Orchid or the top level Lotus Award. A Lotus Sustained Achievement Award is given to schools which receive the Lotus Award for at least three times consecutively.

#### Visual Arts

This year, the Singapore Youth Festival (SYF) on-site exhibition featured 259 artworks selected from over 3400 student artists. Jing Shan submitted two pottery pieces which were selected to be exhibited at \*SCAPE The Ground Theatre between 5 July – 16 July 2017. Both pottery pieces were given the "Certificate of Recognition".

#### Languages

Xia Jiangnan and Pan Luo from Primary 4/1 were awarded Certificates of Commendation and Participation respectively, in the 23<sup>rd</sup> National Primary Schools cum 11<sup>th</sup> Singapore-Malaysia-Brunei On-The-Spot Chinese Creative Essay Writing Competition.

In the Translation Contest for Primary and Secondary Students, conducted by Tamil Language Learning and Promotion Committee, Harshith Arumugam Jeevandoss from Primary 6/1 was awarded a consolation prize.

## 3) <u>Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) Fair, 13 November 2017</u>

CCA is an integral part of our pupils' holistic education. Through CCA, pupils discover their interests and talents while developing values and competencies that will prepare them for a rapidly changing world. CCA also promotes friendship among pupils from diverse backgrounds as they learn, play and grow together. Participation in CCA fosters social integration and deepens pupils' sense of belonging, commitment and sense of responsibility to school, community and nation.

In Jing Shan, CCA is open to all P2 to P6 pupils. The school strongly encourages every pupil to participate in at least one CCA.

## CCA Fair for P1 – P3 Pupils

The annual Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) Fair will take place on 13 November, Monday, for all P1 – P3 pupils. The CCA Fair is a platform to showcase the many CCAs in the school. Pupils will be exposed to all the CCAs available in the school and learn about the new skills they can pick up from each CCA.

In addition, CCA Fair 2017 will be open to all parents from 12.40pm to 1.40pm on that day. Parents are welcome to visit the Fair so as to make an informed decision with your child on the choice of CCA.

#### Online Registration

All P1-P3 pupils are to exercise their CCA option by <u>16 November</u>, <u>Thursday</u>. Registration will be open on AsknLearn from 13 November, Monday to 16 November, Thursday. Pupils who are unable to do the registration at home will be able to do so during their recess on 14 November, Tuesday & 15 November, Wednesday. Laptops will be available in the canteen for pupils to do their registration.

P4 pupils who wish to remain in the same CCA do not have to take part in this registration exercise. Those who wish to switch CCA can register through AsknLearn. P5 pupils should not change their CCA.

On 14 November, Tuesday, the school will be holding a Cyber Wellness Fun Day to educate all pupils about online safety habits. The fun-filled event will be held during 3 recesses and supported by our P3 and P4 Cyber Wellness Ambassadors. The Ambassadors attended the Cyber Wellness Ambassador Workshop during the June holidays and will be displaying the games they had created at the workshop to increase the awareness of cyber wellness issues and values among their peers.

The last day of the academic year in Jing Shan is on 16 November, Thursday.
